## **Chairs Report**

28th August 2019

This has been a busy year for us with a number of significant changes and exciting developments. As ever our core aim is to offer support to bereaved parents. We have been pleased to be able to continue to offer monthly support meetings, I would especially like to thank Claire A for her support with these meetings, having attended all bar 1 in nearly 18 months. We couldn't have done it without you and look forward to you completing your training in the very near future. I am also so pleased that Cara has decided to train as a befriender and will be joining the team soon. A huge thank you to Claire T for her continued commitment to Befriending and all her hard work and support over so many years, I'm sad that she will be standing down from the role but there is a season for everything in life and this season is rightly coming to an end for now. I know we'll still see you but I want to wish you all the best.

In recent months the support group has taken an unexpected turn and become a group for those experiencing pregnancy after loss, as that is the position that all our attendees found themselves in! Whilst exciting, this change was a bit daunting and I am so grateful to Tracey McGrath, who was the previous bereavement midwife at the L&D, for joining us for those meetings. It has been invaluable to have you providing support, advice and answers for parents undertaking this challenging journey, I hope that we will continue to work together.

This year we had the sad task of saying goodbye to Laura as treasurer as she moved away, Laura had been such a solid and central member of the committee for several years and so many of the projects now coming to fruition were seeded by her hard work. The butterfly suite update which she worked tireless with the hospital to plan and agree will soon be completed and Laura will join us for an opening event. The memorial garden project which she worked so hard on is finally happening. On Laura's departure we welcomed Paolo as our new treasurer. Paolo has been the driving force behind getting the memorial garden project to become a reality and I cannot thank him enough for his ongoing expertise, drive and determination to see this project through. The new financial model has frustrated us at every turn but we hope the garden will be ready for BLAW in October.

In the middle of the year we had a bit of a role switch around on the committee and Claire A took on all the hospital liaison role whilst Dalbir became secretary. Thank you to both of you for your commitment and innovation in these roles. Claire has reinstated our relationship with the L&D hospital and continued to work with Bedford to ensure both have what they need in terms of support. As well as ensuring hospitals have all the Sands resources they need, she has also given presentations to staff and discussed plans to improve bereavement care and rooms. She and I have also attended the L&D Maternity Voices group to keep up to date with developments and make suggestions from a bereavement point of view. We are so grateful to both hospitals for their commitment to bereavement care.

Dalbir dragged us into the 21<sup>st</sup> Century and set up cloud based storage that means we can all access documentation more easily. He has worked with Sands central office to iron out some issues with the new email addresses and on designing the new Bedfordshire Sands website which is now live; and I am eternally grateful to him for taking on the Facebook page and making sure both it and the website are kept up to date. And thanks to him we are now all prepped and ready to have meetings by conference call if we need to.

We have had 2 events in the last year for bereaved parents, our Christmas service which was very well attended and a BBQ in the summer, which was less so, but never the less a good time to remember our babies together. During BLAW 2018 we supported 2 churches who were holding memorial services with advertising and practical support on the day, we were also able to incorporate the Sands random act of kindness awareness raising into one of the events. We have not done any formal fundraising this year, the difficulty of setting up funding pots and the need to use our existing restricted funds meant we haven't been able to. But so much fundraising has been done and funds given by supporters of Bedfordshire Sands we are extremely grateful to all for their hard work, bravery, commitment and passion.

We are looking forward to the next year and have so many exciting plans. We intend to have 2 support meetings a month, one for bereaved families and one with a focus on subsequent pregnancies and babies. We also hope that we can get a Dads social group started, Dalbir and Paolo have been keen to set this up and despite a faltering start we hope that it will blossom in the next year. We hope that the memorial garden will be completed over the next couple of months and would like to hold an event there for BLAW. We will again be supporting the churches who are holding services that week. We are looking to further our connection with others supporting bereaved parents by working with Forever a Parent and Chums as well as the hospitals. We hope to see the completion and re-opening of the Butterfly suite at Bedford Hospital and the improvements to room at the L&D to be completed, as well as being involved in the consultation on the new maternity suite that is going to be built there. Our Christmas service will be held in Flitwick again this December.

It has been a year of great change and great progress, thank you to all who have been part of that and to all who are committed to more in the future.

## Treasurer's Report

With the introduction of the NFM all monies are now managed through the Core costs.

All fundraising carried out by members and others has been deposited into the head offices accounts.

The funds raised previously by the group were allocated to pots for the Bedford Hospital Butterfly Suite and the Bedford Memorial Garden.

Head office has paid the grant to Bedford Hospital and the works are scheduled to be carried out imminently.

The Memorial Garden agreement has finally been signed by Bedford Council and head office are awaiting the hard copy to formally approve the project.

The groups intentions are to carry out improvement works in the bereavement room at L&D. As soon as the Memorial Garden agreement has been signed off, the project plan will be submitted for the soundproof door to the room.

The Treasurer is still awaiting clarification from Jen Coates following concerns raised during the London Networking meeting. This has been followed up on a number of occasions with Gail Precious but no response has been received. Any assistance from the East Network coordinator is greatly appreciated.

Also, if the East Network coordinator can assist with obtaining a formal process/procedure from head office which would enable groups to clearly understand the approval sign-off and timescales to avoid possible frustrations from groups.
